
## Our Home Town

- **What do you think of Wimbledon?**  
It's good because it's near central London and places like Kingston or Putney for shopping. It's quite friendly and there's a good bus and train service.

- **How many cinemas are there?**  
There's only one in Wimbledon – but it's got six screens.
- **Do you get all the new films?**  
Yes – they're usually on in the same week as they are in central London.
- **How many discos are there?**  
There are two nightclubs in the town – Cheers and the Watershed.
- **Are there any places for concerts?**  
Small bands play at Wimbledon Theatre or at the Open Air Theatre in summer. But of course the main concerts are at Wembley Arena which is about 45 minutes away.
- **Are there a lot of sports facilities in Wimbledon?**  
Yes, quite a lot. Our schools have got sports centres for aerobics, gymnastics, and so on. There's a good pool in town and several gyms. There is also Wimbledon Common – a public park which is about forty square kilometres and a great place for walking or running, horse riding and flying kites. But Wimbledon is most famous for the tennis tournament every summer and there are lots of places where you can play or where you can have tennis lessons.
