




London- born Sabirul Islam is no ordinary young man in his 20s. In fact, he is one of the youngest and most successful entrepreneurs in the UK. <u>His</u> first experience of business was working for his cousin designing calendars for teachers at their school. This was when Sabirul was only 13 years old and his cousin was only a year older. Unfortunately, Sabirul only had the job for two weeks because his cousin fired him. At the time, Sabirul was upset, but, in fact, his cousin did him a big favour when he fired him. Losing his first job gave him the motivation to start his own company and it changed his life.

**S**abirul set up Veyron Technology with six of his friends when he was only 14. The company designed websites for other companies and in less than two weeks **the boys** made \$ 1000. This was an incredible achievement considering they were so young. Sabirul carried on studying and helping with the supervision of his company until one of his clients invited him to New York. **There**, he learnt about investment and trading and got a job as a junior trader for nine months. This job gave him the inspiration to write his first book. In *The world at your feet*, Sabirul gives young people advice and encouragement on how to become an entrepreneur and make money. The book has sold over 60.000 copies and Sabirul has written two more since it was published.

**A**lthough Sabirul has left school now, he is going to stay in the UK. Right now he is busy with the organisation of his Inspire1 Million world tour. One of Sabirul's greatest skills is communication and so he is going to travel to 20 different countries to give talks on becoming an entrepreneur. He hopes he will inspire a million teenagers to set up **their** own companies. But Sabirul has plans back home, too. He is going to set up two new companies: Teen-Speakers, for teenagers who want to become professional speakers; and Teen-Publishers for teenagers who want to publish their own books.

**S**o, is Sabirul going to stop working before he is 65? He might not. At the moment he is too full of ideas for the future to even think about stopping. He only hopes that he will have enough time to do everything he wants!
